SCBA Management and Implementation Plan

The South Coast Bikeway Alliance (SCBA) is an established 501c3 non-profit corporation. Bylaws are available [here](#). The contract for a feasibility study shall be overseen by the SCBA Steering committee and its Officers.

A Scenic Greenway Subcommittee, to be established, will assist the contractor in scheduling, communications, and regular business. The Subcommittee members will be comprised of a minimum of one representative of each city or town, along with an advisor from the Southeastern Regional Planning and Economic Development District.

- The Subcommittee shall develop and issue a request for proposals to a minimum of three qualified firms, evaluate proposals, recommend a consultant to the Steering Committee and negotiate the final scope of services and deliverables for contract.
- For the duration of the work, Subcommittee members shall coordinate activities within their respective communities and be the prime contact for stakeholders. They will provide monthly progress reports to the Steering Committee and to officials in their respective towns, review and comment on any aspect of the feasibility study as it goes forward and on the draft final report.

During or after the completion of the study, as appropriate, South Coast Bikeway Alliance may seek additional legal or planning assistance from such resources as UMass Dartmouth Law School, and UMass Amherst Landscape and Regional Planning Program to further investigate the issues delineated by the study. To the extent that such issues are restricted to publicly held land in any single Town we may seek resources from that Town or City to assist in resolution.

Proposed duties of the Scenic Greenway Sub Committee are as follows

- 1) Coordinate delivery of all information materials to the Project Manager, including names and contact information of all known stakeholders, plans, research conducted to date, etc.
- 2) Receive and review all communications from the consultant
- 3) Determine a communication plan for regular and efficient information flow
- 4) Confer on a minimum bi-monthly basis(in person or in conference calls) to monitor progress and provide direction
- 5) Attend all public or official meetings regarding the feasibility study
- 6) Provide the initial project schedule and monthly written progress reports to the SCBA Steering Committee.
- 7) Assist in coordinating meetings or information exchange with stakeholders and their official representatives.
- 8) Review all draft and final reports and advise the Steering Committee on any decisions that require Steering committee votes.
