 - ❖ There was discussion about the status of Route 6 improvements at the Fairhaven Bridge. Fairhaven will be advocating for bikers to be instructed to use south sidewalk in order to use ramp down to Route 18/Union street. BD noted that the entire section from Wareham to Fairhaven needs to be looked at for safe pedestrian and bike crossings. The majority of the road in Mattapoisett, Marion and Wareham has only one sidewalk. Jackie said that SRPEDD can do safety audits to start the process with MAss Dot. Town Admin needs to be involved.
